HELMETTA DAY:
September 22, 2018

Dear Residents,

The 2018 Helmetta Day event is scheduled from 4:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M. on Saturday, September 22, 2018 (Rain Date: Sunday, September 23rd) with a fireworks presentation commencing at the 9:00 P.M. hour. Due to this annual event, there will be several road closures that will begin prior, continue through the duration, and cease following the event.

This communiqué has been prepared for your convenience to allow for you to proactively plan your personal schedules and adjust accordingly. The Helmetta Day event will require road closings and/or restrictions from 3:00 PM to 10:00 PM. The closed roadways will be manned by Spotswood Police personnel for your safety and convenience.

The following are the road closures/restrictions:

Roads will be closed from 3:00 P.M. - 10:00 P.M.

- ✓ Maple Street near Regency entrance. Residents will have access in and out through Helmetta Blvd or High Street. The entrance to Regency will not be blocked. Residents from Lakeview Commons will be granted access as well
- ✓ Maple Street near The Lofts entrance. Residents at The Lofts will have access in and out through Main Street.
- ✓ John Street before the bridge. Residents will need to access John Street through Brookside Place.
- ✓ Residents who reside on Ericson, Club & Lakeview will be granted access until 8:00 p.m. Due to safety, there will be no access from 8:00 p.m. - 10:00 p.m. for preparation, during and after the fireworks display.

Residents are encouraged to walk with caution to the event. Limited parking is available at the Community Center located at One Brookside Place.
