- O. The collector of water revenue shall cause to be read every water meter used in the Borough at such times as are necessary that bills may be sent to consumers for the appropriate billing period and also for the purpose of interim meter readings where a request for such a reading has been made by a consumer or his/her representative. - P. Between May 1 and September 15, no person shall make external use of water for any purpose, including but not limited to watering a lawn or landscaping, washing a car, filling a swimming pool or cleaning the exterior of a building, on an odd date unless he or she resides in a house having an odd number and no person shall make external use of water for any purpose, including but not limited to watering a lawn or landscaping, washing a car, filling a swimming pool or cleaning the exterior of a building, on an even date unless he or she resides in a house having an even number, except for newly installed or planted lawns or shrubbery. ARTICLE III Penalties for Violation

§ 57-23. Violations and penalties.

Unless otherwise specifically provided in this chapter, any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be liable for a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.) or imprisonment for a period not to exceed ten (10) days, or both fine and imprisonment.
