WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Helmetta is aware that other similar suburban communities are being unfairly denied access to high-speed internet service, which has become an economic and educational necessity in today's world, and the Borough of Helmetta is supporting the Township of Woodbridge which is leading the effort, with the anticipated support of the state government, to compel public utilities to fulfill their legal and policy obligations to New Jersey taxpayers, and we will forward this resolution on to the Township of Woodbridge to ensure that all voices are heard on this matter; and

WHEREAS, we hereby submit a copy of this Resolution to the Governor's Office and request Governor Christie's intervention and support on this matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BORUCH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF HELMETTA, COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY that:

1. Verizon should immediately fulfill its obligation to provide the infrastructure for high-speed internet connectivity to the Borough of Helmetta and to all other similar suburban communities

throughout the State of New Jersey, as a matter of Verizon's stated agreement to do so with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities, which dates back a matter of decades, and as a matter of sound public policy;

2. A copy of this resolution shall be fully available to the public and to other suburban municipalities who can benefit from the Borough's assistance in compelling Verizon to fulfill its obligations and to help New Jersey achieve its long-standing goal of full internet connectivity for all New Jersey municipalities and a copy of this resolution will be forwarded to the Township of Woodbridge; and
