Rechargeable & Button Cell Batteries (individually bag each battery or tape each terminal end prior to transport). Alkaline batteries can be disposed of in regular trash.

Asbestos containing materials: call to pre-register, must be double bagged.

Non-acceptable Items: Appliances/Furniture, Computers, Electronics, Empty Containers, Explosives and Munitions, Infectious/Medical Waste, Printers, Smoke Detectors, Televisions, Tires.

No containers over 10 gallons.
