- If hiring a contractor for your home project, make sure your estimate includes a permit. If work is done without a permit, the contractor and the homeowner are held responsible and are subject to a penalty not to exceed \$2000.00 dollars, per violation.
- HOUSING INSPECTIONS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL TRANSFERS OF HOMES, CONDOS, TOWNHOUSES. CHANGE OF TENANTS OR OWNERSHIP. AS PER BOROUGH ORDINENCE. Applications can be picked up a the building department.
- If a homeowner applies for a permit and list themselves as the contractor, they are responsible for all work done.
- CONTRACTORS CAN NOT DRAW THERE OWN PLANS.
- Homeowners can draw there own plans, but it shall be recommended by the code official to hire a New Jersey Licensed Architect should the plans lack detailed information.
- Permits are required so that minimum code requirements are met under the Uniform Construction Code in the State of New Jersey. These codes were put in place to protect the health, safety and welfare of all residents and structures, and will be strictly enforced by the Helmetta Building Department.
