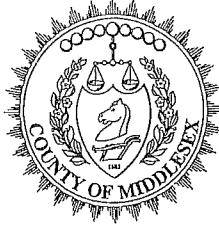

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

RE: Construction/Demolition activities & Source-Separation

As has been discussed at our SWAC and Recycling Coordinators meetings, waste generated through construction and demolition activities is a significant source of potential recycling tonnage.

Plan Amendment 2006-2 mandates for recycling certain segments of the construction and demolition waste stream. New mandates include masonry/paving materials (including concrete, asphalt, brick, and cinder), and white goods for all construction/demolition sites. Also, wood scrap has been mandated for new construction sites only. These mandates are in addition to corrugated cardboard, which has been a mandatory recyclable for all businesses including construction/demolition sites, since 1987. In an effort to ensure compliance within these mandates, the County will step up inspections of these activities for proper source separation of recyclable materials.

Pursuant to Plan Amendment 2006-2, it is the responsibility of the municipal building code official at the time of issuance of any building permit to provide written instruction on proper disposal and recycling of construction and demolition waste and provide a Notification of Construction/Demolition Activity Form. It is the responsibility of the permittee to fill out the Notification Form and fax the form back to the Division of Solid Waste Management within 48 hours of the issuance of a municipal permit.

Enclosed is the Notification Form and information on proper disposal for you to provide to each permittee.

Your anticipated cooperation in complying with this Solid Waste Management Plan mandate will be appreciated.
