Autumn is upon us. Leaf and brush pick up will continue to be picked up Monday through Friday. If your stop is missed it will be picked up as soon as possible. Leaf bags are available at Borough Hall until supplies run out.

Street sweeping will be scheduled for November/December and will be announced when it is on the calendar.

In preparation for the Winter months, please be mindful of neighbors and lend a helping hand when able. When the trucks are out plowing, please note the main focus is on clearing the roadways. As a result, snow will unfortunately be left in front of driveways and on sidewalks. This is not intentional, and we will do our very best to minimize the snow left behind.

Please remember that when you are shoveling to take frequent breaks as well as to not overload the shovel as the weight will add up quickly.

If you have the option to park in a driveway or out of the roadway this will ensure that the road is cleared to the best of our abilities.

Please do your best to clear off your vehicles in your driveway to avoid DPW having to push the snow back onto you or your neighbor's property to ensure the roadway is safe for drivers.

Slow Down In Our Town:

The Jamesburg Police Department is proud to introduce the "Slow Down in Our Town" program, aimed at encouraging motorists to reduce their speed throughout the Borough of Helmetta. This initiative fosters a collaborative partnership between law enforcement and residents, allowing us to strategically place high-visibility lawn signs and a vehicle speed display trailer on borough streets. This is complemented by targeted speeding enforcement conducted by our officers.

Program Details:

Sign Placement: To maintain effectiveness, the signs will be relocated approximately every week. Studies indicate that drivers may become desensitized to signs left in one location for too long. Following the removal of the signs, police officers will conduct targeted enforcement in the area.

Community Involvement: Police Chief James Craparotta emphasizes the importance of this program, stating, "While officers are vigilant in enforcing speeding and traffic violations daily, there is a critical need for innovative traffic safety initiatives." Many resident complaints focus on speeding in residential areas, and this program empowers the community to play an active role in traffic safety.

Targeted Locations: The locations for the "Slow Down in Our Town" program have been selected based on identified speeding concerns and feedback from residents. The targeted streets include Main Street, Maple Street, Lake Avenue, and Old Forge Road.

If you live on one of these streets and wish to participate in the "Slow Down in Our Town" program by placing a lawn sign in front of your residence, please email us with the following information: Name, Address, Phone Contact and Email JamesburgPolice@JamesburgBorough.org

Please note that our goal is to evenly distribute the lawn signs throughout each street. Depending on the number of participating residences, your location may or may not be selected for sign placement.

Here are some important dates for Election Day, November 5, 2024:

October 23: Mailing of Sample Ballots for General Election

October 26 - November 3: Early Voting Period

October 29: Deadline to apply for a Mail-In Ballot by Mail for General Election

November 4 – by 3:00 p.m.: Deadline for In-Person Mail-In Ballot Applications for General Election

Our polling location is at the Helmetta Community Center, 1 Brookside Place, and polls are open from 6:00am to 8:00pm. Be sure to thank our hard-working poll workers if you are voting in person. The Clerk's Office is open all day on Election Day should you have any questions or concerns, 732-521-4946, Ext: 100.

Most importantly, don't forget to get out there and vote, because it really does matter. Your vote is a big deal—it's your voice, and it's waiting to be heard!
