AUTHORIZATION FOR REMINGTON & VERNICK ENGINEERS TO COMPLETE DESIGN OF MAPLE STREET ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Governing Body originally authorized \$15,000 for the preliminary design of Maple Street;
