the activity by the Police Director, the assignment of the necessary extra duty police officer(s) shall be made on a voluntary basis in accordance with a fair and reasonable system established and administered by the Police Director. Any law enforcement officers, when so employed by the Borough shall be treated as an employee of the Borough provided, however, that wages earned for outside employment shall not be applied toward pension benefits of law enforcement officers so employed, nor shall hours worked for outside employment be considered in any way compensable as over time.

### C. Escrow accounts.

- (1) Any person or entity requesting the services of an off-duty law enforcement officer of the Police Department shall estimate the number of hours such law enforcement services are required, which estimate shall be approved in writing by the Police Director, and shall establish an escrow account with the Borough chief financial officer by depositing an amount sufficient to cover the rates of compensation and administrative fees set forth in this section, for the total estimated hours of service.
- (2) Prior to posting any request for services of off-duty law enforcement officers, the Police Director, or his designee, shall verify that the balance in the escrow account of the person or entity requesting services is sufficient to cover the compensation and fees for the number of hours specified in the request for services. The Police Director shall not post a request for services from any person or entity unless all fees and compensation required in the manner described above have been deposited with the Borough chief financial officer. No officer shall provide any such services for more hours than those which are specified in the request for services.
- (3) In the event the funds in such an escrow account should become depleted, services of off-duty law enforcement officers shall cease and requests for further or future services shall not be performed or posted until additional funds have been deposited in the escrow account in the manner described above.
- (4) The person or entity requesting such services shall be responsible for ensuring that sufficient funds remain in the escrow account in order to avoid any interruption of services.
- D. Request for services. All requests for the services of off-duty law enforcement officers for a period of one week or longer shall be forwarded to the Police Director for posting at least ten (10) days before such services are required.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO SIGN SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT IN LITIGATION ENTITLED <u>KAPLAN AT HELMETTA, LLC v. BOROUGH OF HELMETTA PLANNING BOARD, et al.</u>, DOCKET NO. A-5772-09

WHEREAS, Kaplan at Helmetta, LLC ("Kaplan"), the designated redeveloper of the Helme Mill Redevelopment Area, filed a lawsuit entitled <u>Kaplan at Helmetta, LLC v. Borough of Helmetta Planning Board</u>, Docket No. MID-L-2068-10 (Law Division), Docket No. A-5772-09 (Appellate Division)(the "Litigation") challenging the Helmetta Planning Board's denial of Kaplan's application to convert certain approvals that it had for an age-restricted housing project within the redevelopment area to allow for the construction of a non age-restricted project in accordance with the Conversion Act, N.J.S.A. 45:22A-46.3 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough intervened in the Litigation and opposed Kaplan's application to convert these approvals; and

WHEREAS, after the Law Division entered an Order affirming the Planning Board's denial of Kaplan's conversion application, Kaplan filed an appeal which is presently pending before the Appellate Division; and

WHEREAS, prior to issuance of a decision on the appeal, the parties negotiated a proposed settlement of the Litigation which, among other things, would provide for the amendment of the Redevelopment Plan and Redevelopment Agreement to allow non agerestricted housing to be developed within the redevelopment area and for Kaplan to convey Parcels 1 and 2 of the Redevelopment Area to the Borough and to construct an 8,000 square foot community center on Parcel 2 for the benefit of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that rather than incurring the costs and risks associated with this Litigation, it is in the public interest to settle the Litigation, subject to the terms and conditions set forth within the attached Settlement Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Helmetta that the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the Settlement Agreement in the form attached hereto.

### **ORDINANCE # 2011 - 14**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 13 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HELMETTA, ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT," IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENTS

WHEREAS, the Borough Code of the Borough of Helmetta (the "Borough") currently contains Chapter 13, entitled "Police Department" which establishes and governs the Police Department within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to permit members of the Police Department, during their off-duty hours, to engage in certain extra duty police-related activities for private persons or entities under specified circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to supplement Chapter 13 of the Borough Code in order to provide for such police special duty assignments and to establish policy regarding the same.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Helmetta that Chapter 13 of the Borough Code entitled, "Police Department" is hereby amended as follows (additions underscored, deletions struck-through):

1. Add New Section, Chapter 13-19 "Special Duty Assignments."

### § 13-19. Special duty assignments.

A. Authorization for assignments. The Police Director is hereby authorized to permit members of the Police Department, during their off-duty hours, to engage in extra duty police-related activities for private reasons or entities under the provisions of this ordinance. Any and all extra duty assignments must be determined and approved by the Police Director prior to the commencement of such employment. The Police Director shall obtain such information as he deems necessary in order to make his determination as to whether to permit the requested assignment. The Police Director may assign a patrol vehicle for use in performing the requested assignment if the Police Director determines that such patrol vehicle is necessary in order to properly perform the contracted duty. The Police Director may deny assignment or use of police officer(s) or vehicles and/or impose any condition(s) requirement(s) as he, in his sole discretion, may deem to be in the best interests of the Borough and/or the police officer(s) or public safety. The Police Director shall be guided by the nature of the assignment and should avoid those with conflicts of interest and/or high risk of injury.

B. Nature of work. The work to be performed shall be considered as a "special assignment from independent contractors" and will not be considered as a direct assignment. Officers engaged in such assignments shall conform to all Police Department rules, regulations, and procedures. After approval of

### **RESOLUTION # 2011 - 172**

### RESOLUTION OPPOSING SENATE BILL S-2795 WHICH PROPOSES TO DECREASE MUNICIPAL OVERSIGHT OF APARTMENT BUILDINGS

WHEREAS, all apartment communities in the state of New Jersey containing three or more units fall under the state's jurisdiction via the Hotel and Multiple Dwelling Law, whereby the state inspects such multiple dwellings once every five years, and requires owners to register with the Department of Community Affairs; and

WHEREAS, in addition, many municipalities have established their own inspection programs for multiple dwellings by assessing landlords to help pay for inspectors and increased oversight; and

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2011, the state Senate approved bill S-2795, which is expected to be taken up by the Assembly in the fall, and which would prevent municipalities from conducting routine inspections of multiple dwellings containing three units or more; and

WHEREAS, this would mean that periodic inspection of multiple dwellings for compliance with property maintenance codes, and use and occupancy requirements, would be performed solely by the state, and not by a municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council believes that halting local inspections would provide a giveaway to landlords who wield influence and leave tenants of multiple dwellings vulnerable to substandard conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council strongly opposes Senate bill S-2795 in its current form and wishes to make this opposition known to the Borough's representatives in the State Assembly.
