§ 14-1. Creation; appointment of members.

There is hereby created the Recreation Advisory Council consisting of three (3) members to be appointed by the Mayor of the borough with the advice and consent of the Borough Council as hereinafter set forth.

§ 14-2. Purpose.

This chapter is enacted for the purpose of establishing a Recreation Advisory Council in the Borough of Helmetta to help establish recreational programs and activities for all segments of the community and to recommend to the governing body events, activities, purchase and/or lease of equipment and/or lands to meet the present and future recreational needs of the citizens of the borough.

§ 14-3. Membership.

The Recreation Advisory Council shall consist of three (3) members appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Borough Council. Members shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years. However, at the time of their initial appointment one (1) member shall be appointed for three (3) years, one (1) member shall be appointed for two (2) years and one (1) member shall be appointed for one (1) year.

§ 14-4. Organization; officers.

The Recreation Advisory Council shall organize within thirty (30) days after the appointment of its total membership for the remainder of the then calendar year, and thereafter annually by the election of one (1) of its members as Chairman and another of its members as Secretary.

§ 14-5. Vacancies.

Any vacancy occurring by reason of the death, resignation or removal of any Board member shall be filled for the unexpired term by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council in accordance with law.

§ 14-6. Powers and duties.

The Recreational Advisory Council organized hereunder shall have the power to review all of the present and future recreation needs of the borough and make recommendations to the Mayor and Borough Council concerning present and future recreation needs, including the need for any new or additional equipment, building and land. The Council shall issue a written report of its activities and make formal recommendations, if any, at least once annually prior to introduction of the municipal budget.
