Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Helmetta, in the County of Middlesex and State of New Jersey:

§ 45-1. Abandonment of refrigerators without removal of doors or locks prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to leave outside of any building or dwelling any abandoned, discarded and unattended icebox, refrigerator, freezer or any similar article, appliance or container which has an airtight door or lock which may not be released for opening from the inside thereof, unless such person, firm or corporation shall have first removed the door or snaplock from such icebox, refrigerator, freezer or similar article, appliance or container.

§ 45-2. Violations and penalties.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof before the Judge of the Municipal Court of the Borough of Helmetta, be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.) or be imprisoned in the county jail for not more than ninety (90) days, or both, in the discretion of the aforesaid Judge.
