WHEREAS, a proposed WQM plan amendment noticed in the New Jersey Register on October 7, 2013 for the Future Wastewater Service Area (FWSA) map has been prepared by the Middlesex County Office of Planning;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 25th day of September, 2013, by the Governing Body of Helmetta that: The Borough of Helmetta hereby consents to the amendment entitled Future Wastewater Service Area (FWSA) Map, and publicly noticed on October 7, 2013, prepared by the Middlesex County Office of Planning, for the purpose of its incorporation into the applicable WQM planes).
