WHEREAS, the Teamsters have executed the new collective negotiations agreement for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2024; and


WHEREAS, the Borough of Helmetta is desirous of executing the new collective negotiations agreement for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2024.


