WHEREAS, three percent (3%) of the total operating appropriations in the Budget for 2016 was \$80,713.99, of which \$12,673.47 was for the Water Utility Fund; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, in accordance with NJSA 40A:4-48 for the Water Utility Fund budget made as follows: 1. An Emergency Appropriation be and is hereby made for the Water Utility Fund Budget: DEDICATED WATER UTILITY BUDGET: 11. Appropriations for Water Utility Operating: Other Expenses \$ 15,000.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with NJSA 40A:4-48:
