- **WHEREAS,** the Chief Finance Officer has determined that, under the Borough's agreements in place for 2018, it would have cost the Borough approximately \$75,616.88 to provide equivalent services; and
- WHEREAS, RCP Management Company, on behalf of the Association, submitted bills from Jersey Central Power & Light for street lighting for the year 2018 in the amount of \$6,415.52; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Borough is responsible for forty percent (40%) of the street lighting bill as certain of the lights illuminate private parking areas.
